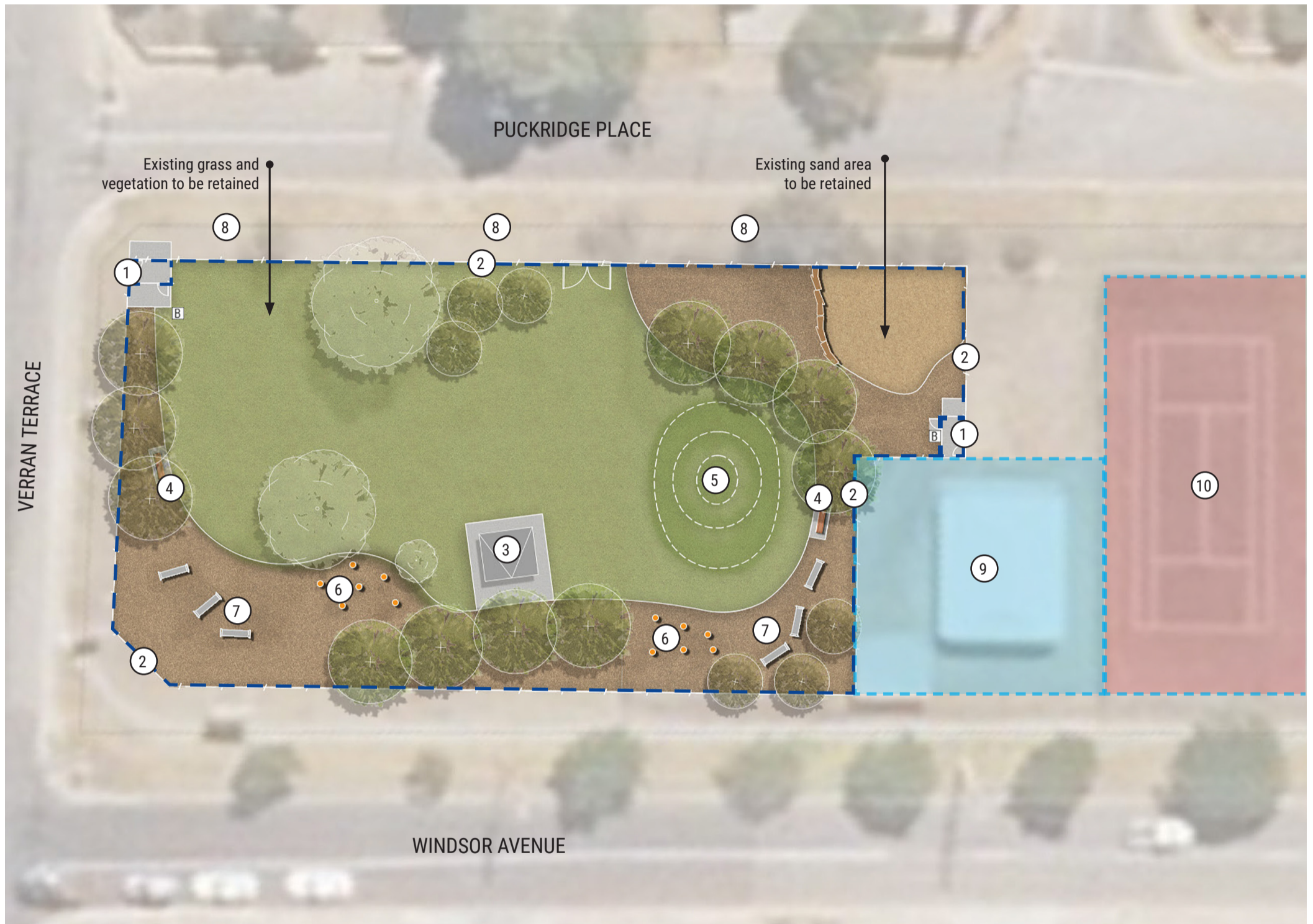


DOG PARK CONCEPT
