### **REPORT DETAIL**

Council received the tabled petition at via email on Thursday 12 June 2025. Pursuant to regulation 10 of the *Local Government (Procedures at Meetings) Regulations 2013* and Council's Code of Practice Council and Committee Meetings Policy 18.63.2, on receipt of a petition, a report must be placed on the agenda for the next ordinary meeting of the council or if received after the Agenda has been finalised, at the following Council meeting. The petition must:

- a) be legibly written or typed or printed; and
- b) clearly set out the request or submission of the petitioners; and
- c) include the name and address of each person who signed or endorsed the petition; and
- d) be addressed to the council and delivered to the principal office of the council.

As per Council Policy, only the first cover page of the petition which provides the details of the Head Petitioner, the subject matter and action that they are seeking Council to consider will be included as an attachment to this report. The full petition will be tabled at the Council meeting.

The petitioners 'draw the council's attention to the proposed revocation of community land status for Harbourview Reserve. We strongly oppose this and urge the council to keep Harbourview Reserve as community land, preserving it for public use and protecting it from future development'.

The Head Petitioner, Tijana Stockham has stated that the petition contains 414 valid and unique signatures. Council Officers have undertaken a preliminary review for errors and duplicate names and have identified that the petition does not contain duplicate names or invalid entries.

As the intent of the petition is already being considered in an agenda item that will be tabled at the July Ordinary Council meeting, it is recommended that Council:
